



Applications Workshop Summary (2016)

- CMS data and publications are being used in support of stakeholder planning and policy at local to state to national scales (e.g. Post-Paris/IPCC Indonesia peat fires, Programa Mexicano del Carbona forest carbon, ARB32 Forest carbon credit on tribal lands)
- CMS Prototypes have led/are leading to operational use by stakeholders and new/improved assessments (e.g. USDA Forest inventory of interior AK, EPA Methane reporting, MD forest cover biomass and afforestation potential)
- Stakeholders generally need high-resolution products for process detail and attribution (e.g. peatland fires, urban GHGs, forest biomass NW, forest wetland biomass)
- Stakeholders request data products easier to get/use (e.g. MD survey, Programa Mexicano del Carbona review), on additional quantities of interest (e.g. city carbon budgets, consumption vs production, gridded natural methane sources), repeated over time (e.g. FIA, EPA, MD DNR, etc..)
